TAQA Arabia in the 24th World Gas Conference & Exhibition in Buenos Aires, Argentina

October 2009, TAQA Arabia participated in the most important event of the global natural gas industry: the World Gas Conference (WGC) and Exhibition, organized by the International Gas Union (IGU) and held in Buenos Aires, Argentina during the period October 5 – 9.



For those of you who may not have heard of IGU, the union members account for 95 % of the world's natural gas production. IGU's work covers all aspects of the industry, from the wellhead to the burner tip. The Union is a worldwide non-profit organization founded in 1931 to promote the technical and economical progress of the gas industry. Registered in Vevey, Switzerland, IGU is made up of gas industry associations and companies from 71 countries, including 75 charter members and 35 associate members. TAQA Arabia has been an associate member of IGU since 2007.

World Gas Conference 2009 in a nutshell

The World Gas Conference and Exhibition are the flagships of IGU. Organized every three years, they are the venue where the results of the newest research done by more than 12 specialized Committees & taskforce within the gas industry and presented to representatives of industrial companies, regulatory authorities

The WGC technical program included 14 keynote addresses, four luncheon addresses, 24 Technical Committee sessions, 9 strategic panels and 18 expert fora. The strategic panels tackled some of the key topics identified during the 2006–2009 triennium.
